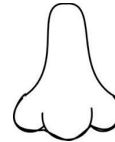

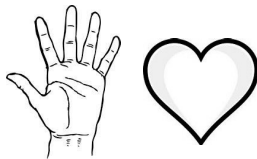

 SUBJECT + **VERB** + **ADJECTIVE**

✓ He looks fat.

 SUBJECT + **VERB** + **like** + **NOUN**

✓ He looks like a pig.

 SUBJECT + **VERB** + **like** + **S V I**

✓ He looks like he ate too much.
