- If we go out, we will drink a lot.
- If it rains, I will buy an umbrella.

#### **↓ HABITS (every time)**

- If I have a test, I study a lot.
- If I get a present, I am happy.
- If my roommate makes dinner, I eat it.

### • Unreal "If" sentences

things that probably won't happen

#### **IMPOSSIBLE**

- If I was an animal, I would be a tiger.
- If I was taller, I would play basketball.
- I would be cute if I was a woman.

#### UNLIKELY

- If I won the lottery, I would buy a house.
- If I lost my job, I would be homeless.
- I would be sad if my friend moved.

## An Example

- I will see my friend if I have time. = I will see my friend.  $\rightarrow$  **FUTURE PLAN**
- I see my friend if I have time. = I always see my friend.  $\downarrow$  HABITS
- I would see my friend if I had time. = I cannot see my friend. IMPOSSIBLE
