EXAMPLES:

S

- 1. A police man was shot by criminals.
- 2. John was given \$5,000 from Susan.

Use when the actor in the situation is not important.

EXAMPLES:

- 1. Trash can be thrown out on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.
- 2. The knife must be sharpened before it can cut anything.
- 3. Spaghetti is eaten with a fork.
