SUBJECT	VERB (+ s)	INDEFINITE	RELATIVE	DESCRIPTION	✓ EXAMPLE
I · you · we · they cats	like don't like	everyone someone anyone no one	who that	is nice are nice	I will date no one who likes shopping more than camping.
he · she · it · a cat	likes doesn't like	everyone someone anyone no one	who that	is nice are nice	He doesn't want to work with anyone who is negative.

SUBJECT	VERB (+ s)	INDEFINITE	RELATIVE	DESCRIPTION	✓ EXAMPLE
I · you · we · they cats	like don't like	everywhere somewhere anywhere nowhere	where that	you can dance are nice	They usually go somewhere that is warm in the winter.
he · she · it · a cat	likes doesn't like	everywhere somewhere anywhere nowhere	where that	you can dance are nice	She doesn't want to live anywhere where you can't go shopping easily.

• Things

SUBJECT	VERB (+ s)	INDEFINITE	RELATIVE	DESCRIPTION	✓ EXAMPLE
I · you · we · they cats	like don't like	everything something anything nothing	which that	is expensive are expensive	Dogs like everything that smells like meat.
he · she · it · a cat	likes doesn't like	everything something anything nothing	which that	is expensive are expensive	That cat wants something that is under the sofa.
