

Difficult Conjunctions

UNLESS

Used to express what will or will not happen if another thing does or doesn't happen. **EXAMPLES**

- 1. I won't go unless you go.
- 2. I will buy this unless you tell me not to.
- 3. They won't work unless we pay them.
- 4. She wouldn't go unless he went.

ALTHOUGH

Used to show contradictory clauses.

EXAMPLES

- 1. I don't like dogs, although I do like Lassie.
- 2. I'm not very hungry, although I could eat some potato chips.

UNTIL

 Used to show that one action will not take place before another action happens. **EXAMPLES**

- 1. I didn't like tacos until I met you.
- 2. He didn't graduate until he was twenty.
- 3. They won't come until you apologize.
- 4. She cried until we got home.

LIKE

Used to show that one action is done in the manner of another action.

EXAMPLES

- 1. He ran like he was on fire.
- 2. She eats like she is starving.
- 3. They love it like fat kids love cake.
- 4. He rides a bike like everything is dangerous.

SO

• Used to show a relationship between the two statements.

EXAMPLES

- 1. I love Italian food so let's go to Saizeria. 2. He's scared of animals so don't take him to the zoo.
- 3. She likes shopping so go to Aeon.
- 4. I forgot my wallet so can I borrow some money?

RATHER / THAN

Used to show that one statement is preferred to another.

EXAMPLES

- 1. I'd rather eat sushi than pizza.
- 2. I'd rather go camping than watch a movie.
- 3. She'd rather buy shoes than jewelry
- 4. Would you rather go dancing or go to dinner?
